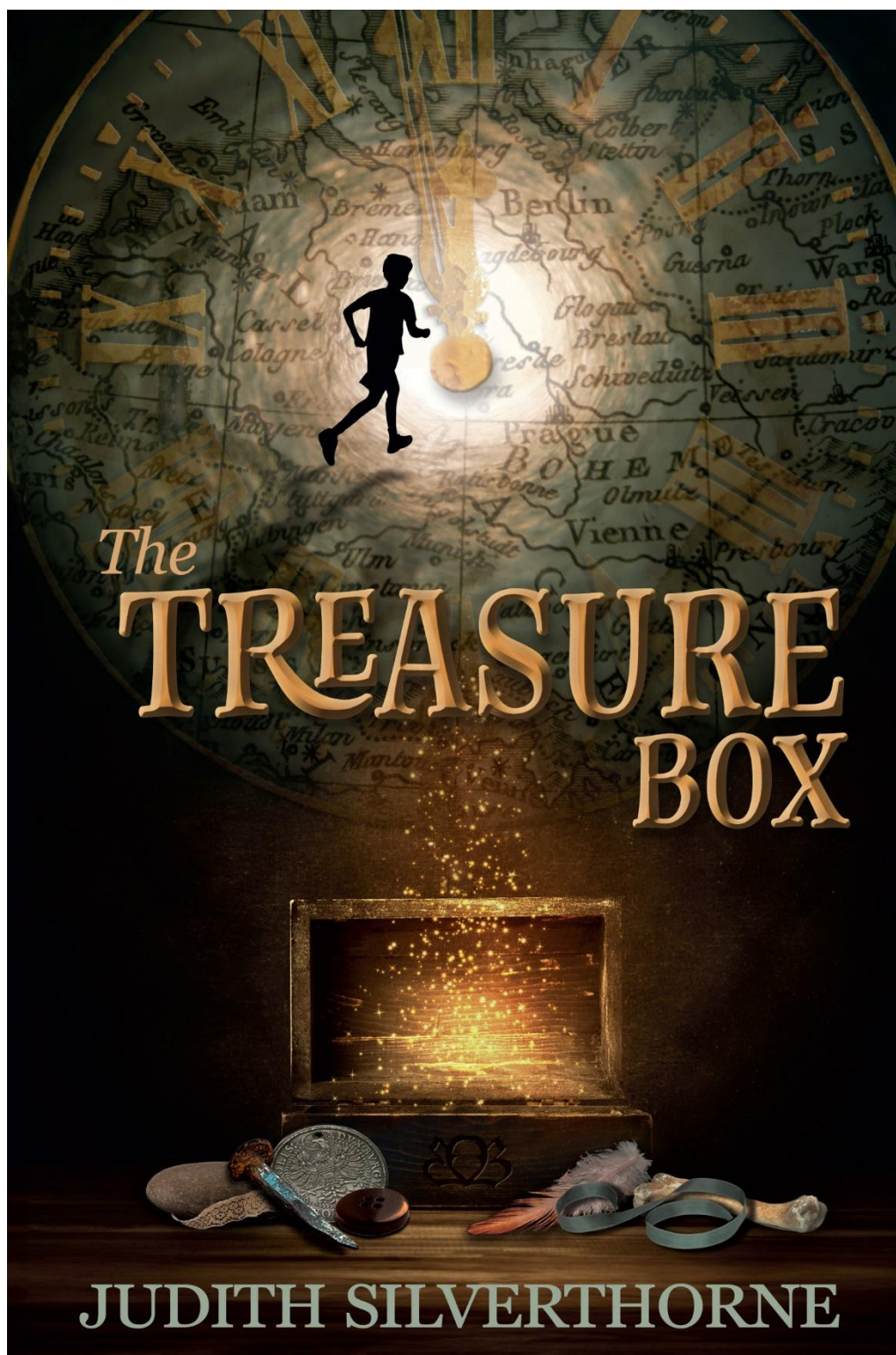

# The Treasure Box Curricular Connections

## Elementary Education:

### Cycle One (Grades 1–2):

- **English Language Arts:** Begin to identify characters' feelings and reasons for their actions.
- **Geography, History, and Citizenship Education:** Recognize that individuals and families have a heritage that contributes to who they are.
- **Physical Education and Health:** Identify habits that contribute to having a healthy mind and body.

### Cycle Two (Grades 3–4):

- **English Language Arts:** Make connections between texts and their own experiences.
- **Geography, History, and Citizenship Education:** Examine how communities change over time.
- **Physical Education and Health:** Identify and demonstrate healthy ways to express feelings and manage stress.

### Cycle Three (Grades 5–6):

- **English Language Arts:** Analyze how characters' motivations and actions influence the plot and resolution of conflicts.
- **Geography, History, and Citizenship Education:** Investigate the diverse groups that have contributed to their communities.
- **Physical Education and Health:** Identify and demonstrate strategies for building and maintaining healthy relationships.
- **Science and Technology:** Describe how living things adapt to their environment.

## Secondary Education:

### Cycle One (Secondary I–III or Grades 7–9):

- **English Language Arts:** Evaluate the effectiveness of different types of texts for various purposes and audiences.
- **Geography, History, and Citizenship Education:** Assess the impact of migration on communities.
- **Physical Education and Health:** Explore how identity influences well-being.
- **Science and Technology:** Assess how environmental changes affect human activity.

### Cycle Two (Secondary IV–V or Grades 10–11):

- **English Language Arts:** Critically analyze themes and issues presented in texts.
- **History of Québec and Canada:** Examine historical events that have shaped society, including immigration and cultural diversity.
- **Physical Education and Health:** Assess the effects of bullying and discrimination on individuals and communities.
- **Science and Technology:** Evaluate past and present human migration due to environmental changes.
